Parking, Bathrooms & Amenities

Parking lot surface: Gravel

Distance from furthest parking spot to path: ~150 ft.

Total number of parking spaces: There are two large parking lots at this site, with estimated space for 60+ cars. There are 3 accessible parking spots, 2 with a direct path to the lake (pictured right), and 1 accessible spot right next to one of the bathrooms



Bathrooms: 2 pit toilets, located at the ends of the parking lot. They have a low threshold to enter and grab bars

Water availability: No water availability at this site

Food availability: No food availability at this site

Picnic tables or benches: There are many tables and benches located around the whole pond. Some picnic tables are shaded under a structure while others are not. Benches are either directly connected to the foot path or are 2-3 ft. off the path in the grass (pictured left)

Shade levels: The fishing platforms and some benches are in direct sun, but there are trees that provide some shade to certain benches around the pond.

Stairs: There are no stairs at this site! The path around the entire pond is paved and well maintained

Surfaces you will encounter: Gravel and pavement

Adaptations and specialized equipment: Pine Grove Pond has 4 fishing platforms that are over the water. These platforms have low handrails to accommodate for someone to be seated while fishing (pictured below)



Man-made obstacles: The parking lot has large rocks placed along the edge (pictured below, left). No measurements were taken of the space between rocks, however these may limit direct access from the parking lot to the walking path. There is 1 gate with a built in passing area to navigate around (pictured below, right)
